CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Seth Coulter called the hearing to order at 10:00 a.m.

On May 3, 2007, a letter of complaint was received from Mary Ann Campbell stating she was injured during a physical therapy treatment by Alicia Rasburry, who is employed by AFCN Physical Medicine. Michael DuPriest, PT is the Director of Physical Therapy Services and Chiropractic Services for AFCN Physical Medicine. Alicia Rasburry is a licensed athletic trainer working as a physical therapy aide at AFCN Physical Medicine.

The Board alleged that Ms. Rasburry did not receive inservice training and was not under the direct supervision of a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant when she treated Ms. Campbell. The allegations constitute unprofessional conduct by Michael DuPriest, PT.

Following review and consideration of the information presented, the Board concluded that items one (1) through five (5) and eight (8) were confirmed as state in the Order and Notice of Hearing. Items six (6) and seven (7) as stated in the Order and Notice of Hearing were not proven. A motion was made, seconded and passed that allegations of unprofessional conduct were not proven and there was no violation of the Practice Act.

The hearing adjourned at 1:00 p.m.
